## RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION IN EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF YOLO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 4th day of December, 1952, determined that a portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of Yolo hereinafter described was in need of fire protection and should be formed into a fire protection district under Division 12, Part 3, Chapter 2, of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors by resolution duly passed and adopted by said Board at said meeting fixed as the time and place for hearing of the matter of the formation of said district the 2nd day of January, 1953, and directed the Clerks of the Board to publish and post notice as required by law; and cay of

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors on the 2nd day of the January, 1953, by resolution duly passed and adopted by said Board: at said meeting found and determined that there were no legal at objections to the formation of said proposed county fire protection district and decided to establish a county fire protection district in Yolo County to be known as "EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT", in the County of Yolo, to consist of the following unincorporated territory within the County of Yolo embraced within the boundaries described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the most southerly City Limits line of the City of Davis inter-sects the centerline of Putah Creek along the north right of way line of Highway U. S. 40 and 99W; thence in a southeasterly direction from said point of beginning along the aforesaid centerline of Putah Greek to County Road 104; thence along County Road Road 35; thence easterly along County Road 35 and extending easterly therefrom to the southeast corner of Section 25, T. 8 N., R. 3 E. M. D. B. & M.; thence north to the northeast corner of Section 36, T. 9N., R. 3E.; thence west to the 1/4 corner common to

WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, sitting in regular meeting on the 2nd day of January, 1953, passed and adopted a resolution calling a special election to be held in said county fire protection district on the 23rd day of January, 1953, for the purpose of determining by the vote of the qualified electors of said district the question as to whether said east DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT shall be established; and

WHEREAS, said resolution calling said election contained and provided for all of the things required by law concerning the holding of said election; and

WHEREAS, the notice of said election prescribed in said resolution was duly published and posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law and as directed by said Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and regularly held in said proposed EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, as directed by said Board of Supervisors, on the 23rd day of January, 1953; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been filed with said Board of Supervisors in the manner and form required by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo has duly canvassed the said election returns of said election;

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California;

- l. That at the special election held in the hereinabove described EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in the County of Yolo there was submitted to the duly qualified electors of said district the proposition: "Shall the East Davis County Fire Protection District be established", and opposite and to the right of said proposal on the ballots voted at said election were printed the words, "Yes" and "No" together with voting squares;
- 2. That there were thirty-nine (39) votes cast at said election; that thirty-eight (38) votes were cast in favor of the proposal and one (1) vote cast against said proposal, to form said East Davis County Fire Protection District;
- 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo find and determine, and it does hereby find and determine, that at such election, that is to say, the election held in the hereinabove described East Davis County Fire Protection District on the 23rd day of January, 1953, a majority of the votes cast ratify the declaration of said Board of Supervisors made on the 2nd day of January, 1953, deciding to establish a county fire protection district within the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo, State of California, hereinabove described, to be known as the East Davis County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo;
- 4. That this resolution making the aforesaid findings be entered upon the minutes of said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo forthwith and that thereafter said East Davis County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo, embracing the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo within the boundaries hereinabove described, shall be deemed to be established and organized, and shall, in fact, be established and organized

as a county fire protection district;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution, together with a map or plat indicating the above described territory, to be immediately filed for record in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Yolo, the county within which the land situated in said East Davis County Fire Protection District is wholly situated, and with the Assessor of the County of Yolo, and with the State Board of Equalization of the State of California.



WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo State of California, on the 4th day of December, 1952, in a regular meeting of said Board, resolved and ordered that that certain portion of Yolo County, hereinafter described, is unincorporated territory within the County of Yolo and is in need of fire protection and should be formed into a fire protection district to be known as "EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF YOLO", and in the said resolution found and determined that said portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of Yolo, hereinafter described, is not included in any forest land protected by the State Board of Forestry of the State of California or in any manner approved by the State Board of Forestry of said State; and

whereas, the said Board of Supervisors in the aforesaid resolution provided and directed that the matter of the formation of such county fire protection district should be heard by the Board of Supervisors of Yolo County on Friday, January 2, 1953, at 2:00 o'clock P. M., at the regular meeting place of said Board of Supervisors of Yolo County in the Supervisors' Room, in the Yolo County Courthouse situated in the City of Woodland, County of Yolo State of California, and fixed said time and place as the time and place for the hearing of the matter of the formation of such fire protection district; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors, in the said resolution, ordered and directed that the Clerk of said Board publish and post notice of the proposed formation of such district and of the time and place of the hearing of the matter of the formation of said county fire protection district in the manner and form required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of said County of Yolo hereby finds and determines that the Clerk of this Board did in fact cause the said notice to be published and posted in the manner

and form as directed by this Board in said resolution and in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, this is the time and place fixed by said Board in its aforesaid resolution for consideration of the matter of the formation of said proposed East Davis County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo; and

WHEREAS, this Board has fully considered the matter of the formation of said County Fire Protection District, and determines that the project is feasible, economically sound and for the public interest; and

WHEREAS, there have been no protests made orally or in writing against the proposed formation of said fire protection district by any person who owns or has an interest in property which might be liable to assessment or taxation for the proposed project or for the payment of expenses or obligations of the district, should the district be organized, or by any other interested person.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, thatsaid Board of Supervisors decide, and it does hereby decide, to proceed to create and establish said county fire protection district under the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, Division 12, Chapter 2, Part 3; that the said East Davis County Fire Protection District in Yolo County, which the said Board of Supervisors has herein and hereby decided to establish, shall consist of all of that portion of the unincorporated territory within the County of Yolo embraced within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at a point where the most southerly City Limits line of the City of Davis intersects the centerline of Putah Creek along the north right of way line of Highway U. S. 40 and 99W; thence in a southeasterly direction from said point of beginning along the aforesaid centerline of Putah Creek to County Road 104; thence south along County Road 104 to

County Road 35; thence easterly along County Road 35 and extending easterly therefrom to the southeast corner of Section 25, T. 8 N.

R. 3 E., M. D. B. & M.; thence north to the northeast corner of Section 36, T. 9 N., R.

3 E.; thence west to the 1/4 corner common to Sections 34 and 27; thence north through the center of Sections 27 & 22 to the north line of said Section 22; thence west to the northwest corner of Section 19 of said T.

9 N., R. 3 E.; said point also being the intersection of Roads 27 and 104; thence south along County Road 104 to County Road 29; thence west along County Road 29 to the intersection of County Road 31; thence west along County Road 102; thence South along County Road 102 to the intersection of County Road 31; thence west along County Road 31 to the centerline of County Road 101-A running southeasterly along the westerly side of the Southern Pacific Rail-road Right-of-Way; thence southeasterly along the centerline of said County Road a distance of 1/4 mile more or less to the northerly City Limits line of the City of Davis; thence following the various courses of the City Limits line of the City of Davis; thence following the various courses of the City Limits line of the City of Davis; thence following the City of Davis along the north, east and southeasterly boundaries to the point of beginning; containing approximately 51.6 square miles.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the said proposed county fire protection district consists solely and entirely of unincorporated territory situated wholly within the County of Yolo, State of California, and does not include any forest land protected by the State Board of Forestry or in any manner approved by the State Board of Forestry.
